Together we feed Diana, the of mother of two who takes care of her young children and ill mother while her husband works, but still can't afford the food their family needs.


Together we feed Eli whose hours were cut and Venjie who could no longer work. The food they got from the Food Bank supplemented from the little they could afford at the grocery store.

On the late afternoon of June 4th a devastating fire burned on the edge of Suisun Marsh not far from our car show site. Several homes burned and the Suisun Wildlife Center was severely damaged. Suisun City Mayor, Lori Wilson immediately set up a GoFundMe page to raise money to rebuild the center. Many of their outbuildings were lost, and some of the animals perished, although many were saved. Ultimately, they lost their beautiful golden eagle, Zuma, from smoke inhalation. In light of this tragic loss to our community, the Board and Officers decided at their next meeting to deliver a check for \$500 in person the next day. Board member, Nick Loya, presented the check while his mom, Kathy took the pictures. The letter below shows just how much our donation was appreciated.

The Board of Directors and I would like to thank you all for your very generous donation of \$500 to help us recover from losses due to the major fire at the Wildlife Center. The Suisun Marsh Natural History Association has rescued injured and orphaned wildlife since 1977 in its Suisun Wildlife Center, and we have released over 17,000 wild birds and animals back to the wild. We are a non-profit, with an annual budget of around \$50,000.





We have an extensive environmental education program, which has served over 300,000 students and adults, focusing primarily on native California wildlife and the Suisun Marsh. Visitors to the Wildlife Center can see our non-releasable education birds and animals on display. Members can take part in classes, field trips, and Wildlife Center events, covered in our quarterly newsletter, "The Otter Chatter". The Chatter features

stories from the Wildlife Center, detailed information about our work, and natural history articles. Your donation includes membership! Please follow us on Facebook at "Suisun Wildlife Center".

Without the help of the public, we could not rescue wildlife and give them another chance at freedom. We are grateful to have your help and hope to be able to see you soon at one of our events!

Nick Loya gave the correct answer, which was:




