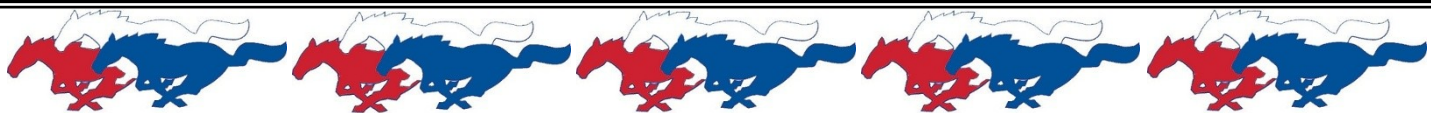

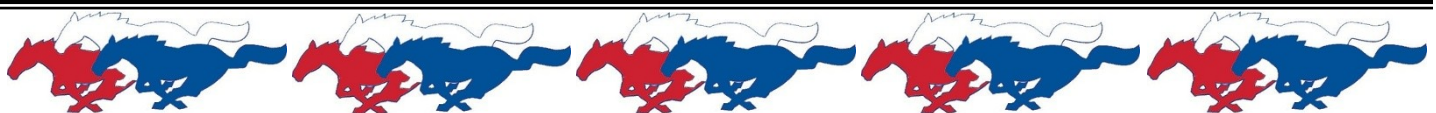
Membership: 2021 is almost here! January 1st is the time to pay your dues!

A big **THANK YOU** goes to Judy and Bill Davis and all of the GHMC members who helped and/or donated to our 2020 Toy Drive.

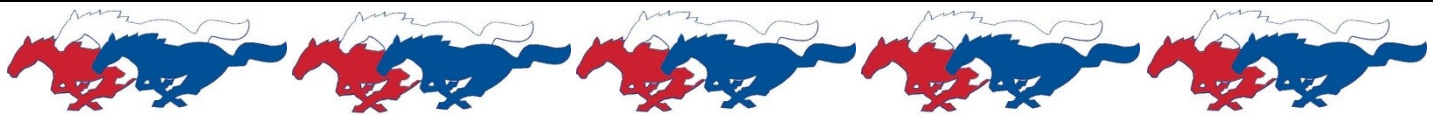
