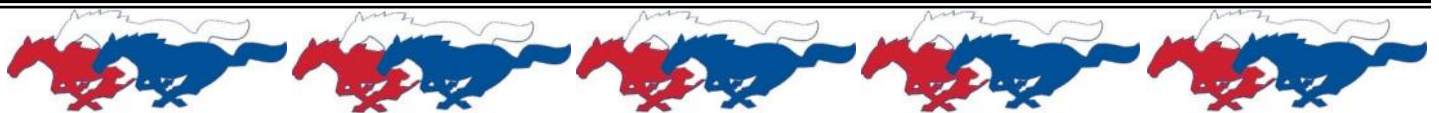

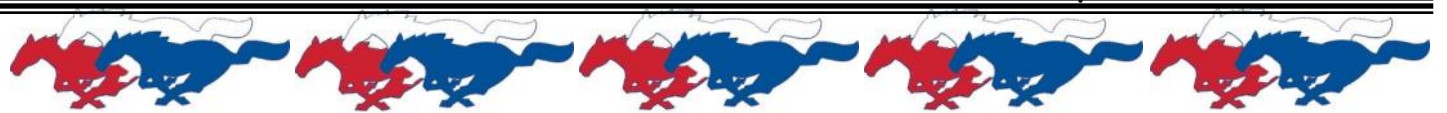
GHMIC Reveals Car Show Logo

Cars & Coffee

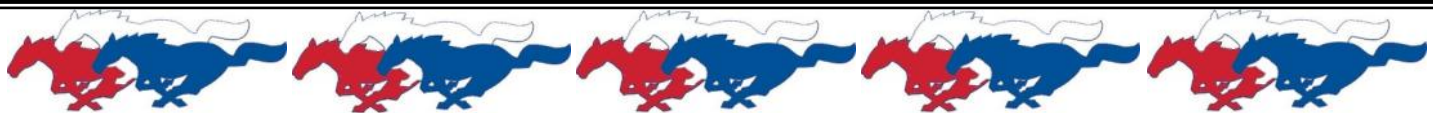
