



The number of cars was down this year with the Golden Hills Mustang Club (GHMC), California Mustang Association (CMA), Bay Area Mustang Association (BAMA), and Sacramento Area Mustang Club (SAMC) showing up with 11 Mustangs total. Returning Stangz crew Brenda Romero was our starter and checkpoint 3 official, I manned checkpoints 1 & 2 (the same location), and Paige handled team check in and gave shop tours.

After a driver's meeting the cars were staged and sent off in 1-minute intervals on the first of three stages. Stage 1 went from Crockett to Pinole on I-80 and then took the backroads heading toward checkpoint 1 near Briones Regional Park. Stage 2 was a scenic loop around Briones Regional Park including downtown Orinda and the backroads of Pleasant Hill to checkpoint 2 (same location as checkpoint 1). Stage 3 continued back up Alhambra Valley and Franklin Canyon to Cummings Skyway and then back to Crockett with views of the Carquinez Straits and Napa River before ending at East Bay Classics for the lunch, awards ceremony, and costume contest. Lunch was again catered by Shaw's Texas Style BBQ and the food was delicious as always. Each entry fee included a \$10 donation to the American Cancer Society, this along with some extra donations came up to \$212. Sue Calvert President of GHMC added a \$100 donation from the club and East Bay Classics added \$100 bringing the total donation to \$412.

After losing the EBay bid on what would become the 24th Mustang in our collection last Thursday I received the perfect Birthday gift the next day when I was contacted by the seller offering me the car at my bid price. So what does it take to get someone with 23 Mustangs to buy another? Well, it has to be special for sure. What could be more special for a guy with a 1979 Indy Pace Car and a 1994 Indy Pace Car than the original 1964 Indy Pace Car? When I got home #24 joined the herd and completed my Trifecta of Indy Pace Cars.

What makes this car so special? Ford produced an initial run of 180 1964 Indy 500 Pace Car replicas as Dealer incentives, there was a shortage so they built what is believed 10 more in a second run. All of the cars were equipped with 260 V8 and C4 Automatics. They were special paint code C (Pace Car White) with trim code 42 (White Interior with Blue Trim). Less than 70 are known to still exist. #24 is one of those 70.




In Memoriam


