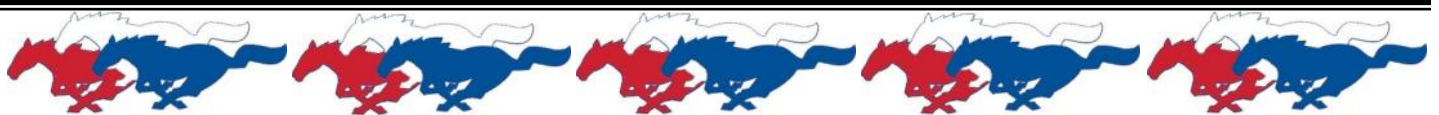

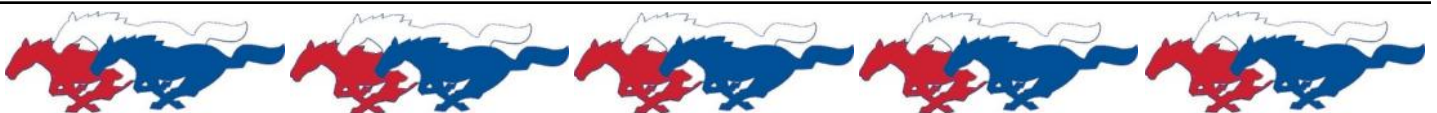

A BLAST FROM THE PAST

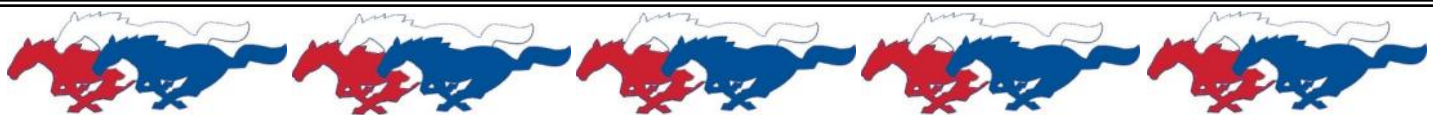

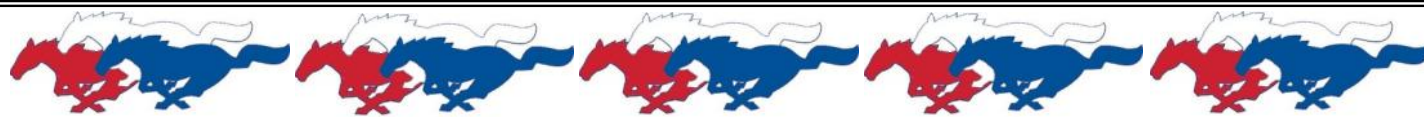

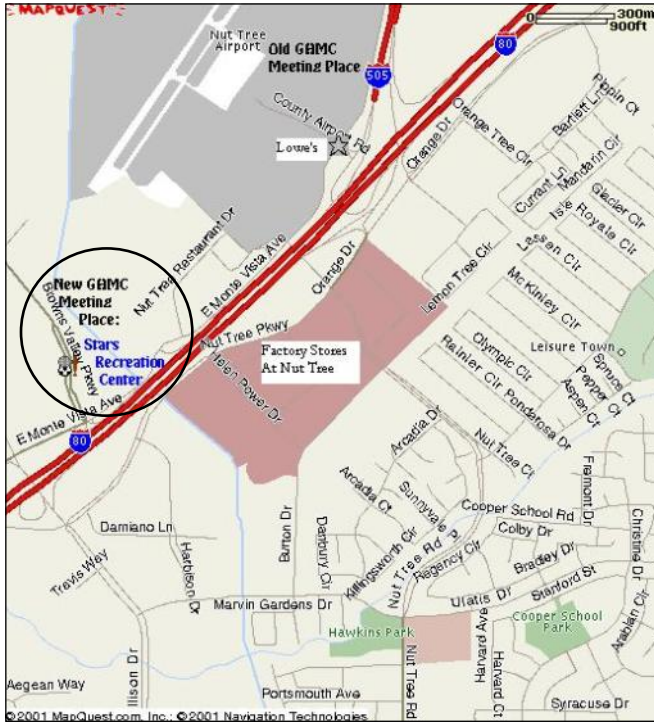
