## GORDON YALLEY FIRE DEPT CAR SHOW

Sunday, October 2nd was the 10th annual (minus 2020-21) Gordon Valley Volunteer Fire Department Car Show held at their station out in rural Gordon Valley, a few miles beyond Mankas Corner. I have attended all of these shows since the very first one, which I recall

was chaired by Bill Banovitz (a fellow fireman) in his Boss 429. Also attending that first show were Kirk Stafford in his '65 Fastback and the late Bob Loya in his '68 California Special. The four of us started a tradition of showing up a little early to get those 5-6 spots right in front of the fire station rollup doors...which was front and center on the "show field" (fancy term for asphalt parking lot)! This show has a capacity for only 40 cars, and during the heyday before Covid, used to sell out a month early as word had spread about what a great show they put on.

This year I was notified by one of the GVFD car show staffers in ~mid-September that they only had about 25 cars signed up, so a plea was made at our September general meeting, and we got a very good turnout from our club. I brought the 1967 Blue Lady and displayed my newly acquired Carroll Shelby six bottle collector wine set on the fold-down rear seat deck, complete with a picture of a car very, very similar to mine! (Thanks Donnie!). I was joined by Jerry and Cyndy in their '69 Mach 1; Dan McCabe in his '69 Sportsroof; Donnie and Lynn-ie in their '65 Truck; Dan & Cristy in their '32 Hot Rod; Yvonne Westberg in her '1940 Ford Hot Rod; Pat, Frank & Drew brought their '65 Fastback, '68 Fastback & '67 Coupe; and Terry & Ileine brought their '68 Coupe. Although we didn't get the "fire station door" spaces, most of us were able to park near each other in the upper lot. So that made 10 Golden Hills Mustang member cars out of the approximate 40 cars in attendance...fourth grade math tells me that's about one in four or 25%! Good job GHMC!

Noticeably absent was Gil Baumgartner, our club founder and long-time Gordon Valley resident, who would usually bring one of his vintage Thunderbirds. Gil and his family were busy doing a family move that weekend. Kirk Stafford and Chervl helped the car show committee with some of the planning and attended but didn't bring a car. The voting this year was simple, it was "peer judging" where only the car owners could vote, and for just ONE car (besides your own) that was your favorite. This was a refreshing change as it combats the notorious "ballot stuffers" who somehow only feel good about themselves for winning a trophy after voting for their own car multiple times! A vintage Camaro "restomod" with a modern drivetrain and all the bells and whistles was the winner this year. My favorites were probably the '57 white Thunderbird (which reminded me of Suzanne Somers in American Graffiti), complete with a periodcorrect vintage suitcase in the trunk with all of Suzanne's personal necessities on display; and long-time Solano County car dealer Avery Greene's GMC truck rescued from the Prescott Ridge, AZ Silver Spurs Ranch!

This car show is one of the volunteer fire department's main fundraisers and has always been held the first Sunday in October if you want to plan for 2023. And it's right here in our backyard in Suisun Valley/Gordon Valley! I hope just as many or more GHMC members can attend next year's show. To summarize, you will enjoy cool cars of all makes and eras, a better-than-your-average-car-show-catered-lunch/BBQ, beverages, beer and wine, more cars, and most importantly, camaraderie with fellow enthusiasts!

Stangz Across the Straits XI the Final Chapter! This year's Spooktacular Halloween Edition will be the last and the end of an era so I thought I would reminisce a little. The event began in 2011 as a cruise from Crockett on the south side of the Carquinez Straits to a private car collection in Richmond and then to lunch at the Boiler House restaurant in the old Richmond Ford factory. The second year we went to tour the USS Iowa Battleship in Richmond and back to the Boiler House. Year three brought a change from the cruise to a 3 -stage road rally hosted from my shop East Bay Classics in Crockett with a catered lunch at the shop after the rally. This proved to be very popular, so we stuck with the format through 2018. After taking office as an MCA National Director in 2019 I stopped putting on the event due to the time and financial commitments of the office. event was resurrected for October 2020 after the Covid pandemic put a stop to all public gatherings for most of the year. With the move from February to October we took the opportunity to add a Halloween costume contest. Over the 11 years the event has had participation from as few as 11 and as many as 47 cars, with as few as 25 and as many as 100 participants. We have raised over \$5000 for charities and collected hundreds of pounds of food for area food banks. I'm a little sad this year was our last but it's time to move on to something else. I'm proud of all we have accomplished and could not have done it without the help of the many volunteers we've had over the years.

On to this year's event, after a driver's meeting 18 cars were staged and sent off in 1-minute intervals on the first of three stages. Stage 1 went from Crockett to Port Costa and Martinez on the backroads to checkpoint 1 near Briones Regional Park. Stage 2 was a scenic loop around Briones Regional

Park including downtown Orinda and the backroads of Pleasant Hill to checkpoint 2 (same location as checkpoint 1). Stage 3 continued back down Alhambra Valley to Pinole and then back on the old Lincoln Highway to Crockett with views of the Carquinez Straits and Napa River before ending at East Bay Classics for the lunch, awards ceremony, and costume contest. Lunch was catered by Shaw's Texas Style BBQ and the food was delicious as always. Now it was time to announce the costume, stage, and the overall winners. Congratulations to Mark & Sherri Pastor who won the costume contest dressed as Winefred & Billy from Hocus Pocus, Greg & Tina Nies winners of Stage 1, Curt Stewart winner of Stage 2, Greg Pretti and Darryl Ott winners of Stage 3, and the Overall winners Dan & Norma McCabe. Dan and Norma, who have participated in 8 of the 11 events and 6 of the 9 rallies had never won so I was super excited to see them take home the top award for the final event.

Thanks to all those who have participated throughout the 11 years, it has been a great pleasure to put on the event!
